International Short Track Speed Skating Competition for the ISU Junior Challenge Series



Białystok, Poland

November 18-20, 2022

ORGANIZER OF THE COMPETITION

The organizer of the competition is ŁKS Juvenia Białystok, acting under the authority of the Polish Speed Skating Association.

LOCATION: Ice Rink, Białystok ul. 11 Listopada 28

The competition will be held in the covered lce Rink with an indoor ice rink measuring 30x60 metres and traditional rink board Padding System. The compass of the track is 111.12 metres with curves of 8 metres as per the ISU Rules. There will be seven (7) tracks with a displacement of 0,7 metre each, while the finish line for all distances is the same and only the starting place of distances 500 metres and 1500 metres will be changed.

GENERAL REGULATIONS

The Competition will be held in accordance with actual ISU Short Track Speed Skating Regulations and the Memorandum 2022/2023.

PARTICIPATION

Only those competitors who have submitted their entries and paid the entry fee by the given deadline are allowed to participate.

Participation in the Competition is only open to ISU members and affiliated clubs. Entries can be made only through the respective members.

Please indicate your intention of participation as soon as possible in order to enable us to prepare the competition as well as possible.

ENTRIES

By submitting an entry the competitor clearly agrees to all terms set in this Announcement.

Preliminary Entries must reach the OC by 1st of November at the latest!

The application rules included in MEMORANDUM JUNIOR CHALLENGE SERIES IN SHORT

TRACK SPEED SKATING 2022-2023 point 2.04 and are the follwing:

- 1. For the combined category Junior A and B the total number of entries shall not exceed 70 for Women and 70 for Men. If either in the Category Women or Men there are less entries than in the other Category more entries might be possible.
- 2. For the purpose of controlling the number of entries the participating field the Organizing Committee, together with the respective Coordinator, may make a reduction in the field of participants in order to maintain the competition format.
- 3. At the moment of the closing of entries (10 days before the Competition) the Organizing Committee will immediately inform all involved whether or not any reduction has been made. This message will be addressed to the person who made the original entry.
- 4. In principle entries can only be made by a Member of the International Skating Union. With the approval of the respective ISU Member, Clubs belonging to this Member may take care of the actual administrative process to make the entries.
- 5. All entries must be made online through the website as specified in the announcement of the respective competition.
- 6. Only in exceptional cases entries can be made by letter, fax or electronic mail to the body or person and within the time limit (closing date) designated in the Announcement for the competition. Such Entries must be confirmed by return of mail, email or fax by the Organizers.
- 7. The skaters will represent the Member or the Club that they are entered by and the name or abbreviation of their country or club will be listed with their name.
- 8. The entry must fulfil all requirements of the ISU Rules (insurance etc.)
- 9. The number of competitors, substitutes, coaches and team leaders shall be entered 30 days before the first day of the competition. See ISU Rules.

The Final Entry must be electronically (www.shorttracklive.info) entered not later than November 9th 2022 and should include the following:

- the given name (first) and surname of each competitor:
- date of birth of each competitor;
- data requested for seeding purposes (personal bests) for all entered competitors;
- the International Registration Numbers (UPID);
- participation in Relay:
- participation in Mixed Team Relay:
- the date and time of arrival and departure of competitors and those accompanying them;
- a financial statement by the respective ISU Member and/or Club that all costs incurred will be covered.

In case of exceeding 70 entries in the main categories Women, Men (JUN A & JUN B), the organizer together with the coordinator, reserves the right to reduce the entries per member, focusing on diversity, regionality (Danubia Region) and performance. Members with high entries will be reduced first based on 500m times or in accordance with the respective Member. The members concerned will be informed at the same time.

- The entry fee must be paid before the start of the Technical Meeting. Please note transponders will only be handed over at the Technical Meeting if payment is fulfilled!
- the deposit for transponders is 50,- EUR/team

EQUIPMENT:

Only that equipment which are in accordance with the ISU Rules can be used in the competitions.

AWARDS:

The first three placed competitors of each distance and category receive a medals, trophies or gifes.

ACCOMMODATION:

All costs of food and accommodation are covered by the teams participating in the competition. OC recommends Hotel Hampton by Hilton Bialystok the hotels listed in the Attachment, which has agreed to give special prices for accommodation and meals.
