GENERAL RULES

The competition will be held in accordance with actual ISU Short Track Speed Skating Regulations.

PARTICIPATION

Only registered competitors of the ISU Member are allowed to participate. The competition is completely open for all ISU Members.

AGE GROUPS

1. In the series the following Categories are applied, for both Women and Men, as specified in Rule 108 of the ISU General Regulations;

Junior C Age 13 and 14

Junior D Age 11 and 12

Age before July the 1st preceding the Competition

2. Entries can only be accepted if a skater is entered into the correct age category according to their date of birth.

COMPETITION

The competitions will be carried out in "Arena Sanok" Poland 4 Królowej Bony Str. measuring 30x60 m. The compass of the track is 111.12 m, according to ISU Rules with curves of 8m. During the competitions there will be used 7 tracks with displacement of 0,7 m each. The finish line for all distances is the same: only the starting place of the distances 500 and 1500 m will be changed: 1000 m and the relays will not be changed.

EQUIPMENTS

Only equipments, which are in accordance with the ISU rules, can be used in the competitions. The compulsory rounding of the corners of the blades will be controlled.

Deposit for helmet cover and transponders is 50 EUR p. Team, which will be refunded at the end of the competition on returning the cover and transponders.

ENTRIES

Individual entries: each ISU Member has the right to enter skaters according to ISU Regulations (Rule 109). Clubs may only enter skaters through their respective Member federations.

Entries can only be made electronically through the Website: www.shorttracklive.info, indicating the right spelling name and date of birth.

Each skater has the right to start in the respective or next higher age category. The skater is not allowed to change the category during the whole season.

NEW skaters can be electronically entered by the respective federation.

These entries should contain the following informations:

- the name of Member Association or Club
- the number of the team members and the list of names (full names),
- the date of birth.
- season best times for each distance (if skaters do not started in this season, time for last season)

The **Final entries** must be electronically entered not later than **September 30**th, **2025**.

The number of participating teams for relays will be determined during team leaders meeting depending of the number of applications.

AWARDS

The first three-placed competitors of the individual competition in the distance ranking will receive medals accordingly.

The skaters of the first three-placed relay teams of each category will be awarded with medals respectively.

RESULTS

All results of the competition series will be published on the website www.shorttracklive.info and www.domtel-sport.pl

There will be live stream from competitions.

LIABILITY

Each competitor participaties in the competition at his/her own risk and assurance. The competition is completely open for all ISU Members.

By entering all participants accept and agree that they might be subject to recording (audio and picture), and might appear in the media content created about the competition.

By entering all participants accept that personal data are collected by the Organizing Committee (OC) and such data are stored and used by the OC, and when necessary, third parties, for the purposes only of, and to the extent necessary only in relation to facilitate their participation in the competition; personal data may include but will not be limited to full legal name as per national identity documents, address, date of birth, nationality, sex.
