1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The Southeast Asian (SEA) Trophy Manila Series 2024 will be organized by the 2022 Regulations of the International Skating Union (ISU) and relevant ISU Communications, and the conditions included in this announcement. This international competition is sanctioned by the International Skating Union (ISU) as per Rule 107-18.

2. PARTICIPATION

Participation in the Southeast Asian (SEA) Trophy Manila Series 2024 is <u>OPEN</u> to all ISU members. Entries should be submitted through each ISU member using the official forms provided herein (refer to Page 4 for full information).

Competitors who are not citizens of the ISU member they represent will be required to adhere to ISU Rule 109 stated in ISU Communication 2526.

3. COMPETITION FORMAT

All Final system.

The drawing and seeding procedure will follow ISU Rule 296. Qualifying rounds will follow the naming specified in ISU Rule 295-2-d. A maximum number of scheduled skaters for the Final Race will follow ISU Rule 295-2-e.

Final points (34, 21, 13, 8, 5, 3, 2, 1) will be awarded in the respective Final A and Final B following ISU Rule 295-5, Rule 297-7.

Skaters can ONLY skate in ONE (1) individual category and ONE (1) relay category.

The program is subject to change by the Organizing Committee, as it may deem necessary.

<u>Team Leaders must confirm the list of competitors during the Team Leaders and Officials meeting.</u> The organizing committee must receive documented proof that the competitors are in transit and will arrive in due time for the SEA Trophy. Competitors who do not comply with these requirements will be excluded. The detailed program will be published online one week before the competition.



6. COMPETITION REGISTRATION, ENTRY FEES and DEADLINES

Registration

Entries for the competition will be available online starting <u>July 21, 2024</u>. Only entries submitted through the provided registration platform will be accepted until <u>August 15, 2024, 23:59 (GMT+8)</u>. A copy of the passport and ISU clearance must be submitted with the registration form.

All registrants are required to provide their personal best time for all the distances that they intend to race.

Competition Entry Fee

(Per skater regardless of number of races/distances)

- Instructions on how to proceed with registration and payment of entry fees will be sent to each ISU member. There will be no refund for withdrawals for any reason.
- Competition fees must be paid on or before 30th August 2024.
- Late registration is allowed from <u>16 August 2024 until 30th August 2024</u> with an additional **late fee of USD 35.00** per skater entry.
- Registration after 1 September 2024 23:59 (GMT +8) will not be entertained.
- Withdrawal from the competition for any reason after the closing date of registration is still subject to entry fees.

Relay Entries

Each ISU member has the right to enter one (1) mixed-gender relay team consisting of **2 ladies** and **2 men** <u>per category</u>. Depending on the number of participating skaters, Mixed relay can be composed of mixed-gender, mixed-countries per team.

7. TRACK CONDITIONS AND RINK DIMENSIONS

SM Skating Mall of Asia is an artificially refrigerated indoor ice surface with 30x60 square meter dimensions with complete cover pads by Rule 280 of the ISU. The tracks are under Rule 280-5a.



8. HELMET COVERS AND TRANSPONDERS

All skaters (local and international) will be issued helmet covers and transponders. Each skater is required to submit a cash deposit of **USD \$100** upon registration, which will be refunded at the end of the competition upon returning the helmet covers and transponders.

The helmet covers and transponders must be worn during races.

9. ID and EQUIPMENT

Skaters and Officials will be given an ID to access the area during the competition days. The organizing committee reserves the right to inspect the skater's equipment before and during the competition.

Skaters must have/use all safety equipment such as but not limited to – shin, knee, and neck guards, ISU-compliant helmets, and gloves, during competition. All skaters must wear a <u>cut-resistant racing</u> <u>suit as defined by ISU regulations to protect the body as suggested in ISU Communication No. 1265 and meet the criteria EN388 level 2 of the ISU regulations or cut-resistant undergarment.</u>

10. COACHES AND OFFICIAL'S BRIEFING

The Referee may give a briefing on rules at a date and time set by the organizing committee. Coaches, Team Leaders, and Officials are encouraged to attend.

11. AWARDS PRESENTATION CEREMONY

A ceremony will be held to close the competition and for awards to be presented to the winners. Medals will be awarded to the top three competitors in the individual events and to each winning member of the winning relay team.

Certificate of Participation in the competition will be available during the awarding ceremony on 29th September 2024. Skaters may claim their certificate from their assigned Team Leader/s.

12. MEALS, LODGING, TRAVEL and OTHER EXPENSES

All expenses incurred by competitors of each participating ISU member will be the responsibility of the individual.

13. CITIZENSHIP / RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS AND CLEARANCE PROCEDURE

Under Rule 109 of the ISU Regulations and the current ISU Communication, all skaters who do not have the nationality of the member by which they have been entered, or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate.

14. LIABILITY and MEDICAL INSURANCE

In accordance with Rule 119 of the ISU General Regulations, the ISU, the Philippine Skating Union (PHSU) and the organizing committee assume no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection with the competition. Each member is solely responsible for providing insurance (medical and accident) for their athletes.

18. AIRPORT PICKUP SERVICE
