INTERNATIONAL SHORT TRACK SPEED SKATING COMPETITION

Serbian Skating Association and skating club "Intro Line" have the honor to invite your team to the Serbia Open short track speed skating competition from 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> of December 2024.

The Serbia Open 2024 STSS competition is associated with the Alpe Adria Trophy competitions, supported by the ISU Development project and it will be held at the "Pionir" ice rink located at Čarli Čaplina 39, Palilula, 11000 Belgrade, Serbia [GPS 44.816056; 20.484250]

The track is an indoor Ice Rink, with the measures of 60 x 30m, with a standard track of 111.12m. Beside the original track there will be four extra tracks set up to preserve good ice conditions. Padding will cover the boards in dangerous areas.

## RULES



The All Final System will be applied.

The first round of the first distance shall be made on the basis of the personal best time supplied with the Final Entry.

Final Points will be awarded in the A Final races only. No points will be awarded to Skaters or Teams who receive a penalty, a yellow card, a red card, "did not start" or "failed to finish" the race. The points 34, 21, 13, 8, 5, 3, 2, 1 are awarded in descending order commencing with first place.

For the Final Classification the skaters are ranked:

- by total number of Final Points
- by combined ranking over all Distance Classification
- by the highest ranking achieved in one of the distances and subsequent other best rankings
- by best time over the longest distance on the program  
[See Rule 295]

Please note that the organizer reserves the right to modify competition system according to number of competitors and available time.



# CATEGORIES

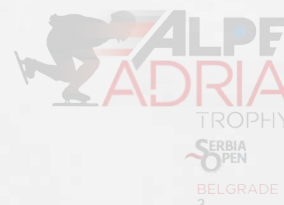
Ladies and Men (Girls and Boys) will be divided into the following age groups:

Seniors	19 and older	30.06.2005. and older
Juniors A	17 - 19	30.06.2007. - 01.07.2005.
Juniors B	15 - 17	30.06.2009. - 01.07.2007.
Juniors C	13 - 15	30.06.2011. - 01.07.2009.
Juniors D	11 - 13	30.06.2013. - 01.07.2011.
Juniors E	9 - 11	30.06.2015. - 01.07.2013.
Juniors F	7 - 9	30.06.2017. - 01.07.2015.
Juniors G	7 and younger	01.07.2017. and younger

Please note that the organizer reserves the right to join certain age groups in races, after consulting with the Competitor Steward, if there is not enough skaters in the individual groups. There is also a possibility of mixed gender groups. Results will be calculated for each group separately independent from grouping in the races.

Group A Men/Ladies - 3000m (Seniors, Juniors A and B) – teams of 4 skaters

Group B Men/Ladies - 2000m (Juniors C, D and E or F) – teams of 3 skaters

Gender-mixed teams are allowed in the Relay category Junior C, D, E /F

## EQUIPMENT

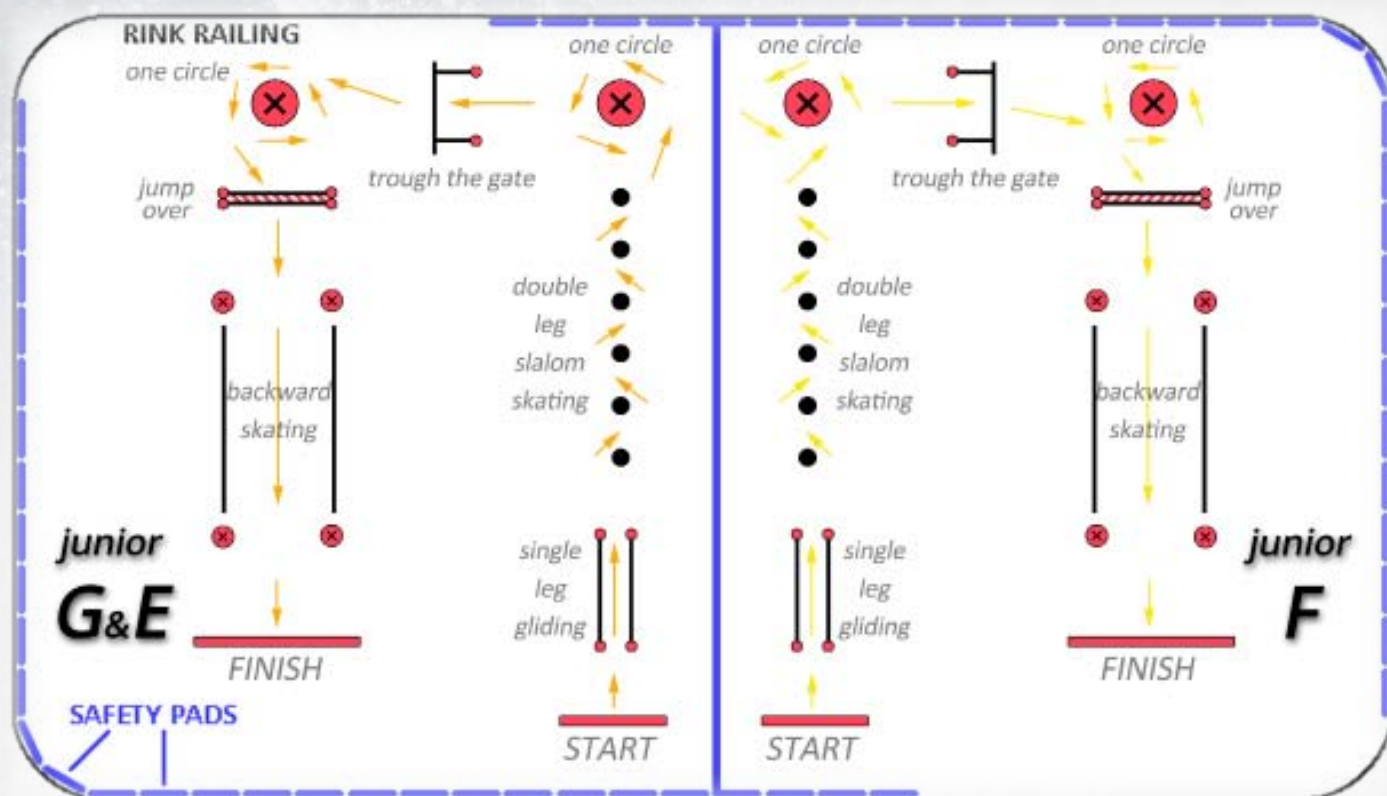

# SKILL RACES



For the categories Junior G, F & E there will be organized skill races as a part of skill & coordination development fun activities on ice.



Skill races will be organized on the first day of the competition, prior to the regular competition program. They are a fun way of stimulating skating enjoyment for the kids in more “game” oriented way on ice and a good opportunity for stimulating skating related activities where kids have fun and develop themselves in a variety of ways, without the pressure of competing and yet within the exciting and inspiring environment of an international competition.
