EQUIPMENT

Only equipment, which is in accordance with the ISU rules, can be used at the competitions.

AWARDS

The first three-placed competitors of the individual competition in the distance ranking will receive medals accordingly.

The skaters of the first three-placed relay teams of each category will be awarded with medals respectively.

Bulgarian Skating Federation and Organizing Committee, assume no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection with the Competition.

Each Member is solely responsible for providing insurance (medical and accident) coverage for their athletes.

LIABILITY

Each competitor participates in the competition at his/her own risk and assurance. The competition is completely open for all ISU Members.

By entering all participants accept and agree that they might be subject to recording (audio and picture), and might appear in the media content created about the competition.

By entering all participants accept that personal data are collected by the Organizing Committee (OC) and such data are stored and used by the OC, and when necessary, third parties, for the purposes only of, and to the extent necessary only in relation to facilitate their participation in the competition; personal data may include but will not be limited to full legal name as per national identity documents, address, date of birth, nationality, sex.

The OC provides medical service (ambulance) during the competition

ACCOMMODATION

All costs of food and accommodation are covered by the teams participating in the competition.
